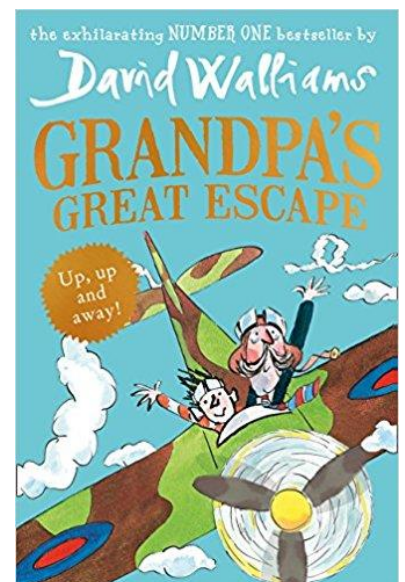
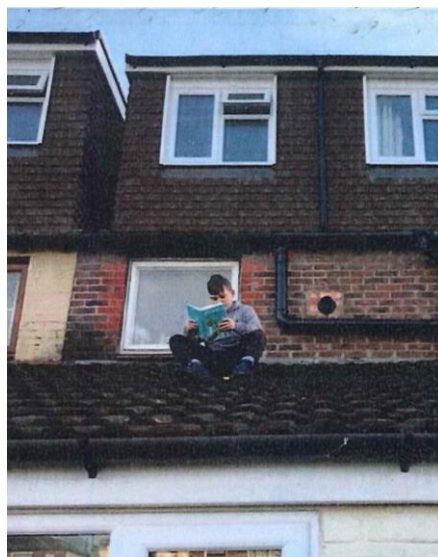


Book review by Joshua
