- ✘ Show respect to all members of staff

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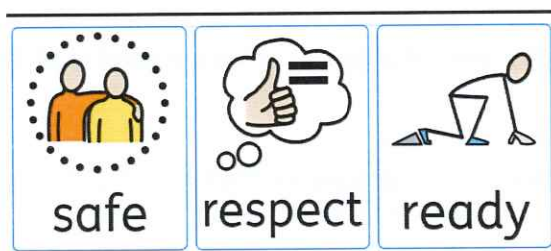
Our commitment to you is to:-
