Target 2016-17 - Achieved Comments (All these targets below were achieved along with the Gold Status Sainsbury's sports award)

- Continue to include professional development for the staff in line with the new curriculum and safety - Appointed New PE Coach for KS2, Golden Mile initiative training has been completed and CPD twilights have been attended.
- Make sure planning/assessment is in line with new curriculum. - New assessments have been developed and carefully utilised to ensure all children are making progress and developing new skills through a devised set of plans.
- Continue to develop the enhancement opportunities for as many children as possible. - External links are continuing to be made and monitored to ensure opportunities are available for all children.
- Develop whole school events (Race for Life already being planned for the children to take part in at school in Autumn). - Intra competitions have taken place to add focus to Sports Day and develop team cohesion. Race for Life successfully took place as a whole school event raising money for charity.

Target 2017-2018

- Continue for PE to be taught progressively throughout the school each day using the National Curriculum framework.
- Continue with all children meeting or exceeding national expectations in PE by Summer 2018. (All pupils to progress at 90% or more).
- To develop use of all sporting equipment available, enabling a wider range of resources to enhance the childrens experiences with in PE.
- Play Leaders to continue supporting breaktime games.

- Gold Kitemark maintained.
- Increased participation in after school sport clubs to be recorded.

Impact 2016-17 :

- Each class has $\frac{1}{2}$ hour PE every day.
- Increased encouragement to have a healthy lifestyle through development of vocabulary and activity/skill development.
- Specialist sport coaching - new opportunity for community involvement links with Portsmouth Tennis Centre and UP for Sport Girls Football and PITC. Links have been made with Portsmouth Schools' Partnership and community sports clubs. Coaching has been offered as a result of offers made to the school and through Miss Smith's personal involvement in sports.
- Increased involvement in a variety of competitions and activities across the city, providing opportunities for all year groups and increasing participation outside school.
- Non-participants/able/'disadvantaged'/SEND identified and targeted for ASCs/activities and competitions
- A significant feature of this year has been that PE provision has sought to extend and broaden pupils' experience of physical activity as a life-long skill. Groups of children have attended festivals and competitions outside school as part of their PE programme. This has both deepened their learning and ignited their imaginations about the possibilities of sport activity. A range of children have been chosen or selected to attend events for a variety of reasons, not just sporting achievement.
- On average 92% of pupils attained the national average in PE. On average across the school 25% of pupils are working at depth.

Children's Courses/Events/Festivals/Shows

Highbury primary School are proud to belong to the Portsmouth School Sport Partnership, which firmly believes sport, and all that it encompasses truly can change the lives and aspirations of young people, and it contributes towards the achievements of each individual's potential in all facets of their personal development. PE and Sport at Highbury Primary School develops personal, social, physical, creative and cognitive skills and helps the children to develop a knowledge and understanding of fitness and health, determination, resilience, courage, self-belief and communication.

All Portsmouth Primary School PE competitive opportunities are identified as Gold, Silver and Bronze levels. This helps to assist with Talent ID, feeding into clubs and participation only.

GOLD- Winners/ Runners up can on go on to represent Portsmouth at county level.

SILVER- Emphasis on winning, winning teams are presented with medals and certificates.

BRONZE- Emphasis on participation, although certificates/ medals awarded for top boy/girl and showing PE values.
