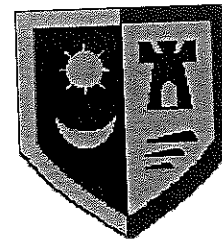

Dear Parents and Carers

This year we will be sending out the children's annual reports at the end of the spring term instead of the summer term. We will be reporting to you on what your child has achieved so far this academic year and the next steps for their learning.

This school year a new National Curriculum has been introduced and the children in years 1-6, are working towards the end of year expectations rather than the old system of 'levels'. The report will indicate whether your child is achieving age related expectations, working towards that expectation or exceeding age related expectation, for this time of year.

This will be reported as follows:

As the reports will be written next half term and sent out on Thursday 24th March we will not be holding parents evening as previously arranged for February 22nd and 23rd. The reports will contain a specific target for each child in years 1-6 for both maths and literacy. The Reception children will have next steps for each area of learning. We hope you will support your child with these targets, as they progress towards their end of year expectations.

We will be holding parents evening during the summer term for you to discuss your child's progress since their annual report has been written. This will be on Monday 23rd May and Tuesday 24th May.

The children in year 2 and 6 will also receive a written summary of their Statutory Assessment Test results and the End of Key Stage Teacher assessments in July. The Reception children will receive their Foundation Stage profile
