What's happening in EYFS?





During this half term we will be exploring the theme 'What do you celebrate?' We will focus on getting to know each other's traditions within our families and how these may differ. We will be learning about different celebrations locally and from around the world. We also look forward to the Nativity performance by YR and Christmas Craft workshops in Nursery.





Communication and Language

We will be talking about our families and our traditions that we follow and what this means to us. We will be listening carefully to each other's ideas and experiences. There will also be opportunity to learn new language and vocabulary linked to different celebrations.

We will ask the children to contribute to our bank of ideas for this half term in relation to each celebration. There will be opportunity for dressing up and role playing different celebration scenes, as well as a variety of arts and craft activities.
