


# What's happening in EYFS?





During this half term we will be exploring the theme 'All About Me!' We will focus on getting to know each other and settling back into our routines. We will also be taking the time to learn about our new value heroes and following the school rules. As we move into October we will learning about the change in season and signs of Autumn.



### Communication and Language

We will be talking about our likes and dislikes as we start to get to know each other and form friendships. The children will also have the opportunity to talk about their families and loved ones.

We will be listening carefully and retelling familiar stories.

We asked the children to contribute to our bank of ideas for this half term. They would like to share some family photos with their friends and teachers. It would be great to share these on Famly as a talking point for your child ©

Family photos will be displayed within the classrooms and the children may draw a family picture. We hope to create a family book within each class for the children to look at together.



The children will be exploring the inside and outdoor environments and learning the daily routines.

#### **Physical**

In nursery, the children will be practicing their mark making skills. Children in YR will be learning to form letter sounds as part of their phonics learning. All of the EYFS children will develop these skills through sensory experiences to strengthen their hand and finger muscles.

# <u>Personal Social and</u> <u>Emotional</u>


We will be working on building the children's selfesteem and confidence by sharing their experiences in small groups. Children will be encouraged to take turns, listen to each other and show respect to their friends.
