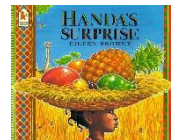




# What's happening in EYFS?



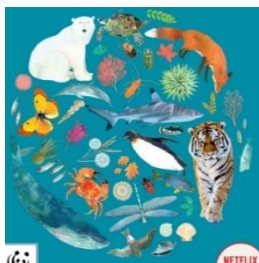
During this half term we will be exploring the theme of 'Our Wonderful World'. We will focus on a different story each week which is set in a different part of the world. At first the children will explore where they live and the features of the local community. We will then learn about different parts of our wonderful world such as outer space and Antarctica. We also look forward to celebrating the King's Coronation, learning about the city of London and British Values.



## Communication and Language

We will be talking about our local community and exploring new vocabulary when learning about different parts of the world. We will be listening carefully to stories and noticing where the story is set. The children will learn how to say hello in languages from around the world.

We will ask the children to contribute to our bank of ideas for this half term in relation our wonderful world. There will be many opportunities for the children to learn about the world around them and talk about their own experiences in different places local to them and around the world.



Remember, talk is a great tool for learning so please encourage your child to talk about what they have done each day.

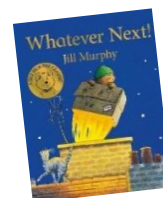

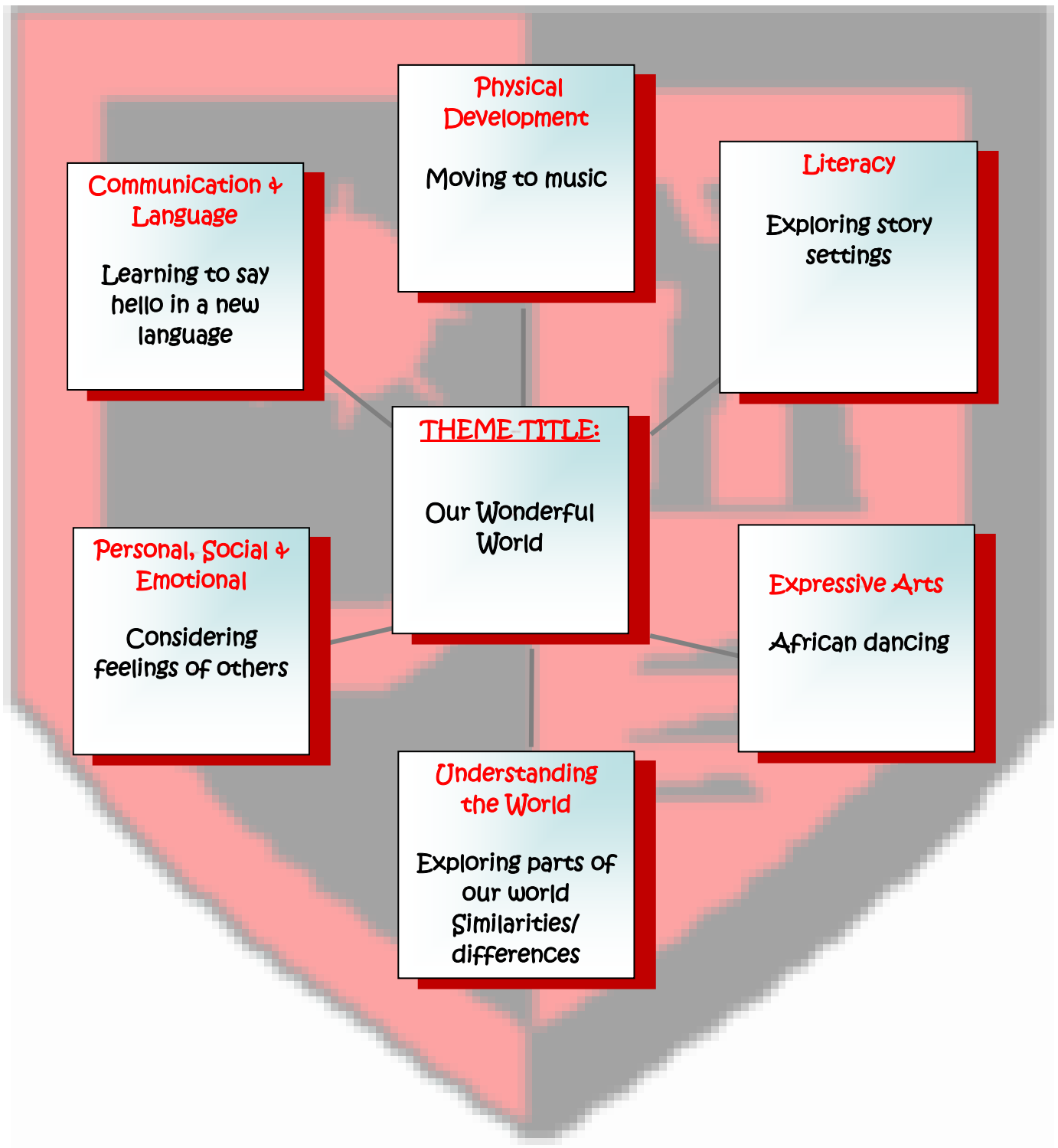
## Family
