Why does the school have a PTA?

Our group is called Highbury Primary School PTA and we are a registered charity. We have been running for over 10 years, and we're a lively group of volunteers.

The main function of our PTA is to support the school by raising as much money as we can to enhance, enrich and improve learning experiences for the children. We also provide those 'little extras' that make school memorable.

We also exist to bring the communities of school and home closer together because it makes sense for parents to be involved in the life of their chosen school.

Lastly, we're here for the simple reason that we want to get together socially, meet new people and have fun!

The PTA is run by a committee who are all volunteers, with support from teaching bodies at our PTA Meetings.

How we keep you up-to-date with our activities?

Facebook group	We post notices about all upcoming meetings on our Facebook group and page, as well as reminders about events and requests for volunteers. Our Facebook group for Parents/Carers only is a private group for those with children at the school, and is called 'Highbury (Portsmouth) Parents and Carers Information' Our Facebook page is open to the public, and can be liked by friends and other family members, so they can see our events and what is currently going at at the school. We only shows our events on this page, no images or personal information is posted on this page. The page is called 'Highbury Primary School PTA Portsmouth'.
Book bags	We put flyers, sponsor forms and notices in book bags.
Newsletter	We have a newsletter once a term which we put into book bags and on the PTA noticeboard.
Online Communication tool	We post notices about all upcoming meetings on our Facebook group as well as reminders about events and requests for volunteers.
Noticeboard	The PTA noticeboards are located at the entrance to the main playground, and also at Year 1 Playground. These are updated at least once a month.

What are we raising money for next?

Our next big project we are raising money for is outdoor sports canopies, so whether it be rain or shine the children can still benefit from PE/Sports, as our current indoor hall is not large enough for some sport activities.

To achieve this goal for the children and the school, we will be doing more fundraising events for the school and we are looking for any new ideas to help achieve our goal.
