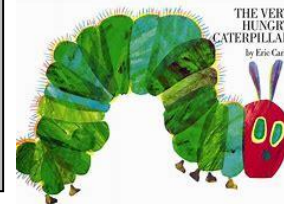


What's happening in EYFS?



During this half term we will be exploring the theme 'All About Me!' We will focus on getting to know each other and settling back into our routines. We will also be taking the time to learn about our value heroes and following the school rules.



Communication and Language

We will be talking about our likes and dislikes as we start to get to know each other and form friendships.

We will be listening carefully to the stories that link with our class names to gain a sense of belonging- Julia Donaldson/Eric Carle.

Personal Social and Emotional

We will be working on building the children's self-esteem and confidence by sharing their experiences in small groups. Children will be encouraged to take turns, listen to each other and show respect to their friends.



We asked the children to contribute to our bank of ideas for this half term. They would like to share some family photos with their friends and teachers. It would be great to share these on Family as a talking point for your child 😊



Physical

In nursery, the children will be practicing their mark making skills. Children in the Whales and Snails classes will be learning to write different letters through their phonics sessions. All of the EYFS children will do this through sensory experiences to strengthen their hand and finger muscles.

Reading

We ask that you support your child by sharing stories with them each day at home and ask them questions about what they can see in the pictures. In YR, we will provide you with a reading log where you can record the stories you have shared with your child. Your child will have the opportunity to take home a book from our Early Years library.



The children will be exploring the inside and outdoor environments and learning the daily school routines.

Remember, talk is a great tool for learning so please encourage your child to talk about what they have done each day.

Family

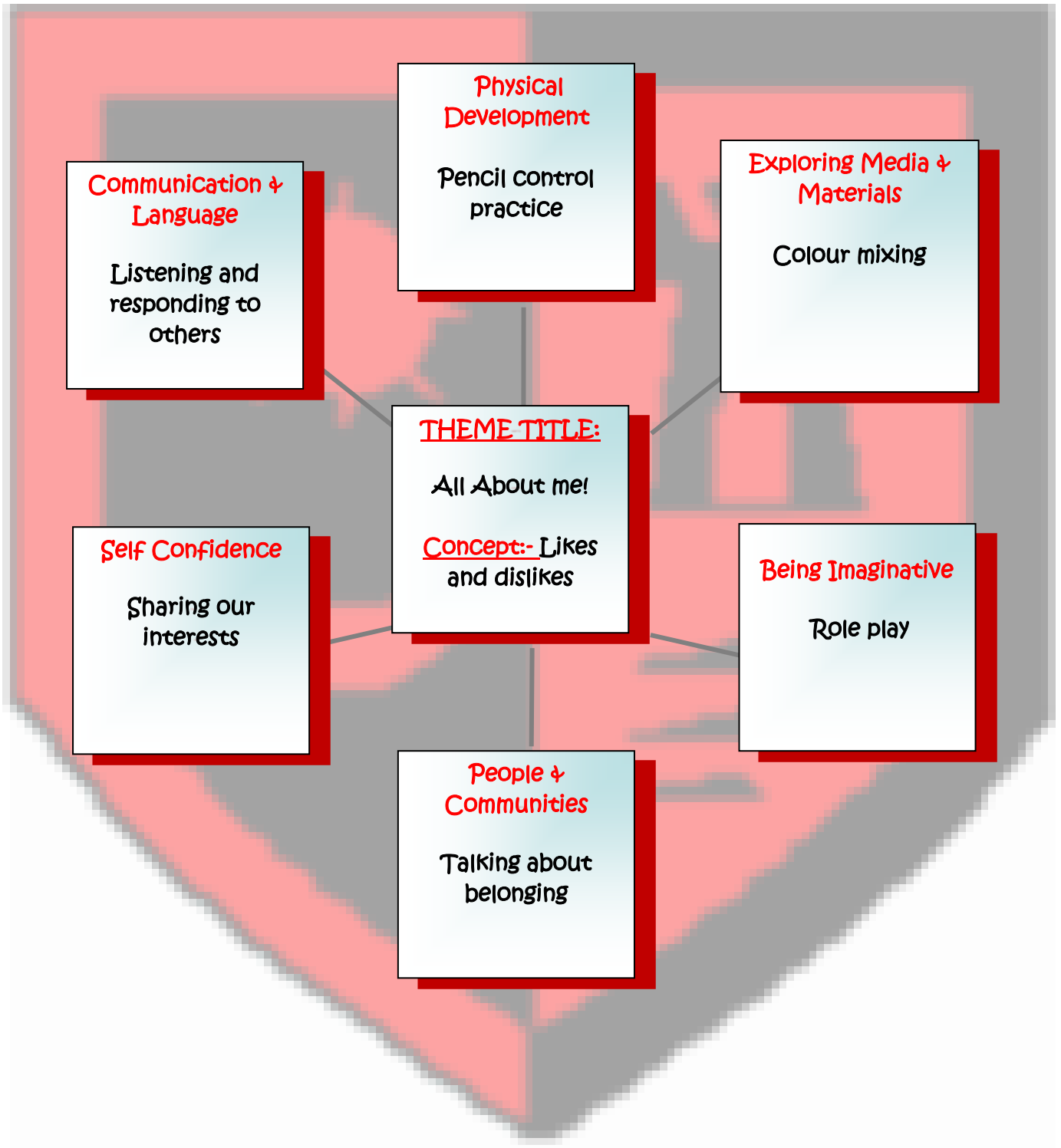
