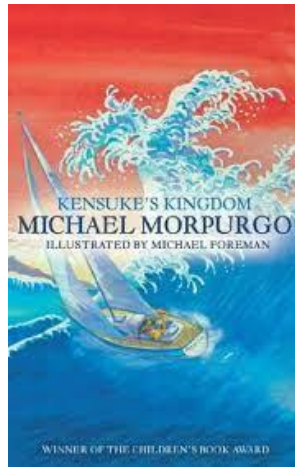


What's happening in Year Five?

Please also ensure you label all jumpers and cardigans, this way they should eventually find their way back to your child, if they misplace them.

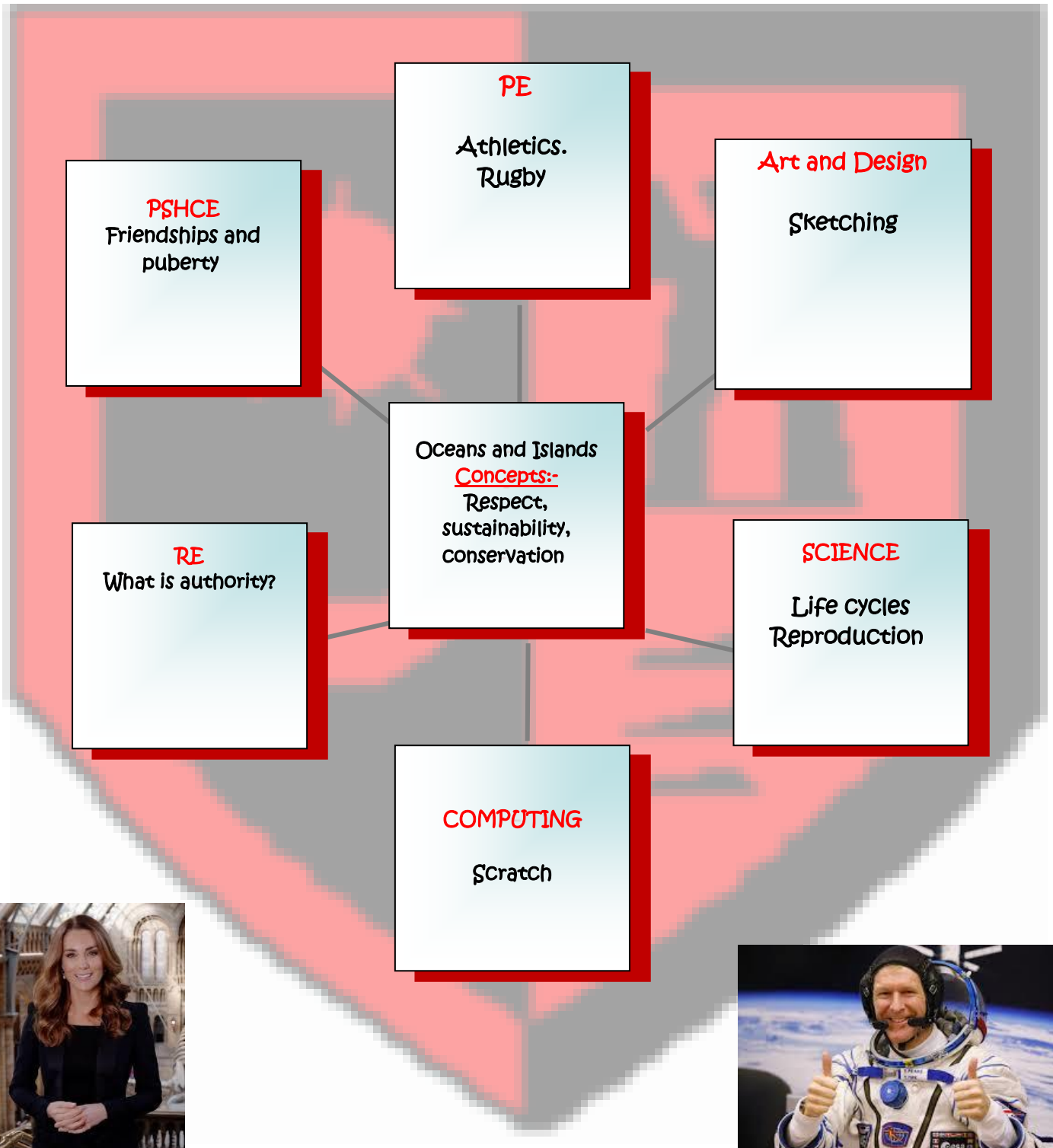
