

What's happening in Year Six?

During this half term we will be exploring the theme 'Why is the Amazon amazing?' The focus of this theme is the Amazon rainforest's physical and human geographical features.

English

During English lessons we will be learning the writing skills needed to write an effective survival guide for the Amazon. We will also be learning the skills needed to write an effective recount. As a class we will be reading 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell, as well as reading a range of non-fiction texts about our theme.



Maths

In Maths we will be learning about the place value of large numbers up to 10,000,000. We will also be looking at strategies to calculate using both mental and written methods. We will be reasoning about numbers and solving problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

The school will continue to set homework each week. This will include a range of tasks including spellings, reading, maths, English and theme. Homework will be set on a Thursday and will need to be turned in by Tuesday morning.

Encouraging your child to complete their homework each week will ensure they practise skills learnt in class.

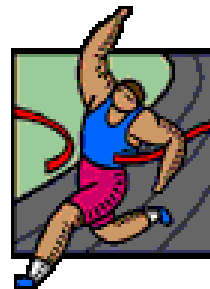

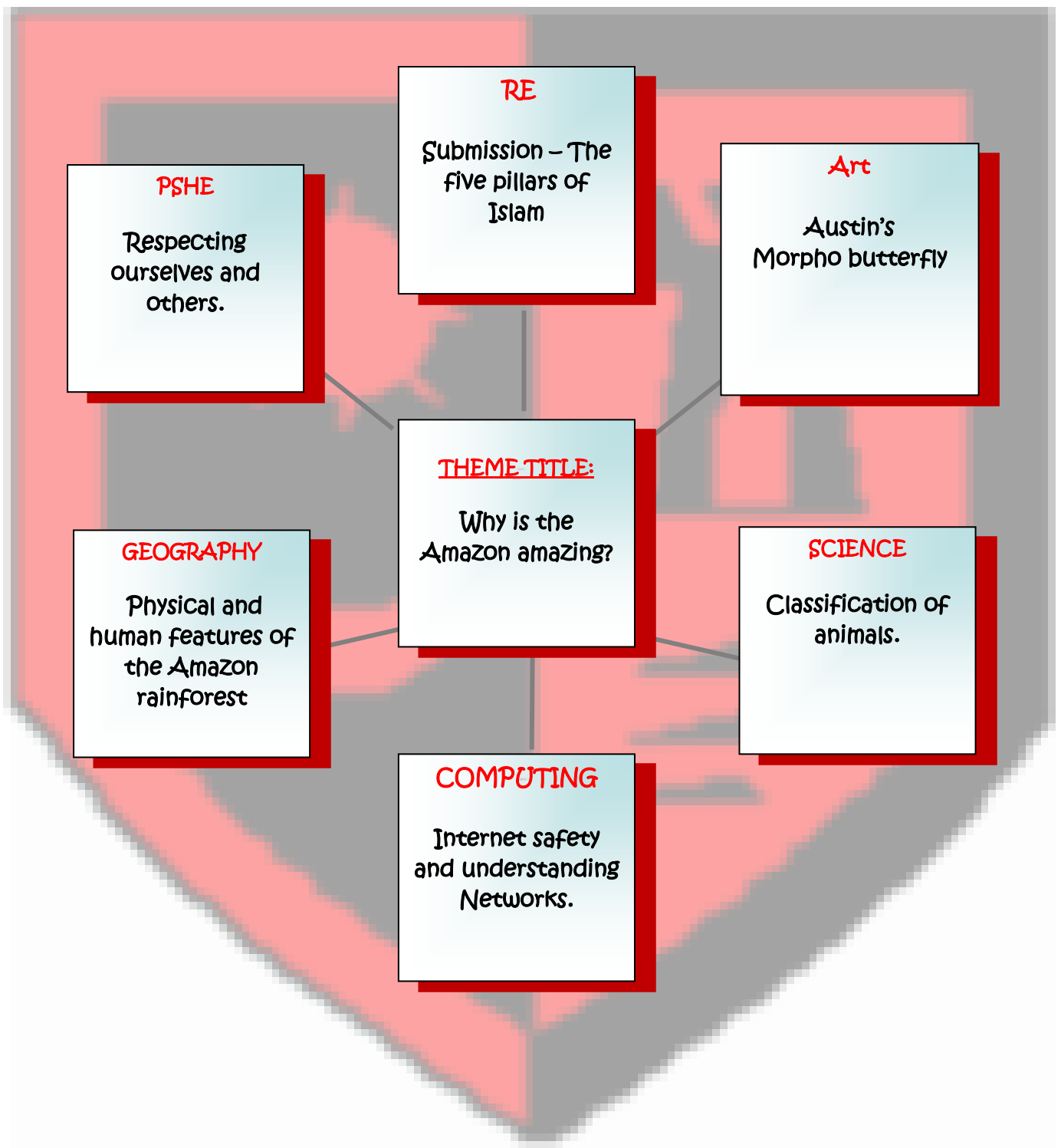
