Communication and Language



We will be working on building the children's self-esteem and confidence by sharing their experiences in small groups. Children will be encouraged to take turns, listen to each other and show respect to their friends.

Family photos will be displayed within the classrooms and the children may draw a family picture. We hope to create a family book within each class for the children to look at together.

Reading
We ask that you support your child by sharing stories with them each day at home and ask them questions to check their understanding. In YR, we will provide you with a yellow reading diary where you can record what your child has read.



The children will be exploring the inside and outdoor environments and learning the daily routines.

Remember, **talk** is a great tool for learning so please encourage your child to talk about what they have done each day 😊


Physical
In nursery, the children will be practicing their mark making skills. Children in YR will be learning to form letter sounds as part of their phonics learning. All of the EYFS children will develop these skills through sensory experiences to strengthen their hand and finger muscles.
