
## What's happening in Year Four?




During this half term we will be exploring the exciting theme 'How have electrical inventions improved my life?'



During English lessons, we will be reading Operation Gadgetman by Malorie Blackman, which is an exciting adventure story on the theme of inventions. The children will be writing setting descriptions using expanded noun phrases, sentence openers and similes to help them. Later on in the half term, they will be writing instructions related to their theme lessons.

In Science, the children will be looking at electrical safety in the home and the community. They will be learning about making circuits and investigating which materials are conductors or insulators of electricity. They will apply these skills in Design Technology.






## Homework

As part of our Design & Technology, will be we designing and making a simple light up Christmas card using our knowledge of circuits.
